



Bailey Boswell Road/Bridge Project Update

Construction:

Phase 1 – 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive to FM 156 – January 2015 to December 2015

Phase 2 – Business 287 to 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive – Fall 2015 to Winter 2016

Phase 3 – 2 Lane bridge over Bus. 287 and Railroad - Fall 2016 to Fall 2017

Project Status Update – July 2015

Phase 1 – Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell from 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive to FM 156: The design is complete and the project was bid and been awarded to JLB Contracting Inc. The Construction Contract was awarded on September 23, 2014.

The storm drain and water lines have been installed along Bailey Boswell. The excavation along the southside of Bailey Boswell Road began in early June and paving of the southern half of the road is planned to be complete by end of July.

AT&T relocations are anticipated to be complete along FM 156 and Bailey Boswell by mid July.

The storm drain crossing FM 156 is planned for late summer once AT&T relocations are complete. Construction is anticipated to be complete late this year.



Phase 2 – Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell from Business 287 to 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive: The design is underway and anticipated to be complete by Fall 2015.

The permitting process with BNSF Railway and UP Railroad is in process and anticipated to be complete by Fall 2015. Easement and right-of-way acquisition process is underway.

Franchise Utility Companies (gas, underground cable, overhead power, fiber optic) have begun design for the relocations and the construction for the relocations will begin late Summer.

The project is estimated to go out to bid in August and start construction this fall. Construction will take 14-18 months.

Phase 3 – Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell Overpass: The 60% design is underway and the 60% submittal will be submitted to the City and TxDOT for review.

The permitting process with BNSF Railway and UP Railroad is underway.

The bridge aesthetics options are being finalized to be presented to the City.

What Can I Do to Prevent the West Nile Virus?


The easiest and best way to avoid West Nile Virus (WNV) is to **prevent** mosquito bites.

When you are outdoors, use insect repellent containing an EPA-registered active ingredient. Follow the directions on the package. Being outside means you're at risk. The more time you're outdoors, the more time you could be bitten by an infected mosquito. Pay attention to avoiding mosquito bites if you spend a lot of time outside, either working or playing.

Many mosquitoes are the most active from dusk to dawn. Wear long sleeve shirts, long pants and socks sprayed with repellent if you plan to be outdoors when mosquitoes are most active. Or consider staying indoors when the mosquitoes are biting.

Make sure the screens on your windows and doors are in good shape. This helps keep mosquitoes from getting indoors.

Get rid of mosquito breeding sites by emptying standing water from flowerpots, buckets and other things that hold water. Change the water in pet dishes, and replace the water in birdbaths weekly. Drill holes in tire swings so water drains out. Keep children's wading pools empty and on their sides when they aren't being used.



Garage Sale Information

Garage sale permits must be obtained at Saginaw City Hall at least 48 hours prior to sale. The cost of the garage sale permit is \$5.00 which includes three signs per garage sale (1 yard sign and 2 directional signs). Additional signs are prohibited. No signs shall be placed on utility poles. The owner or occupant of residential property is allowed two (2) sales per calendar year. The garage sale permit can not exceed three consecutive days. The permit must be displayed on the premises during the sale.


