### TUESDAY & FRIDAY


Non-residential sites (apartments, businesses, parks, common areas)

### Saginaw Resident Usage Fees

- Daily Fees (All Ages / Non-Membership): \$5/day
- Adult Membership (ages 16 - 54): \$40/year
- Youth Membership (ages 15 & under): \$30/year
- Senior Adult Membership (ages 55 - 64): \$10/year
- Senior Adult Membership (ages 65 & up): FREE
- Family Membership (family of four): \$125/year
- Additional Adult Family Member: \$35/year
- Additional Youth Family Member: \$20/year

### Non-Resident Usage Fees

- Daily Fees (All Ages / Non-Membership): \$10/day
- Adult Membership (ages 16 - 54): \$130/year
- Youth Membership (ages 15 & under): \$60/year
- Senior Adult Membership (ages 55 - 64): \$40/year
- Senior Adult Membership (ages 65 & up): \$30/year
- Family Membership (family of four): \$325/year

# October 10th is "Saginaw Recycling Day" (Hazardous Household Waste Disposal Event)

**DOCUMENT/PAPER SHREDDING:** Instant Shredding will be on site.

**FLAG RETIREMENT:** American & Texas flag retirement

**BULK WASTE ACCEPTED:** Tree limbs, brush, furniture, tires, bulk household waste and appliances. Refrigerators, air conditioners or any appliance containing Freon must have proof of Freon removal attached to the appliance.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE ACCEPTED:** Acids, aerosol cans, antifreeze, batteries (all kinds including car batteries), brake fluid, cooking oil, craft chemicals, degreasers, drain cleaner, fertilizer, fluorescent light bulbs, compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFL's), herbicides, household chemicals, motor oil, paints & stains, paint thinners, pest strips, pesticides, pharmaceuticals, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, oil filters, solvents, transmission fluid and varnish.

**WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED:** Commercial or Industrial waste, ammunition, asbestos, building materials, butane cylinders, electronics, explosives, medical waste, PCB's, propane cylinders, radioactive material, smoke detectors and TV's.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPOSING OF WASTE:

→ If a product is still usable; give it to someone instead of bringing it for disposal.

- Bring liquid paint sorted by type (i.e. latex, oil based and lead based).
- Keep chemicals in their original containers; place broken or leaking containers in a second container of like material (i.e. glass for corrosives, metal for flammables).
- If a container has no label and the contents are known, please place a label on the container clearly stating the contents.
- Do not transport chemicals in the passenger compartment of your vehicle. Put in your trunk.

**RESIDENTS OF SAGINAW:** Must provide a current residential water bill.

**DATE:** Saturday, October 10th from 9:00am to 11:00am. (Due to limited capacity only vehicles in line before 11:00 am will be admitted. The line will close at 11:00 am or earlier for household hazardous waste if capacity is reached.)

## Have a Garage Sale in Saginaw!

One person's trash is another person's treasure. It's Fall in Saginaw and there is not a better time to host a garage sale! Garage sale permits must be obtained at Saginaw City Hall at least 48 hours prior to sale. The cost of the garage sale permit is \$5.00 which includes three signs per garage sale (1 yard sign and 2 directional signs). Additional signs are prohibited. No signs shall be placed on utility poles. The owner or occupant of residential property is allowed two (2) sales per calendar year. The garage sale permit can not exceed three consecutive days. The permit must be displayed on the premises during the sale.

**Have Your Garage Sale Listed Online:** If you choose to place your sale information on our website, it is an additional \$5.00. It will be listed on the City of Saginaw website at [www.SaginawTx.org](http://www.SaginawTx.org). For more information, call City Hall at 817-232-4640.
