



Bailey Boswell Road/Bridge Project Update

Project Overview:

East Bailey Boswell Road will be widened from a 4 lane undivided asphalt roadway section with ditches to a divided concrete roadway with curb and median. The roadway section will be 6 lane divided roadway from Bus. 287 to Jarvis Road then transition to a 4 lane roadway with right turn lanes from Jarvis Road to FM 156. The project will also include a 2 lane overpass (1 lane each direction) over Bus. 287 and both the Union Pacific and Burlington Northern Railroads.

Construction:

Phase 1 - 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive to FM 156 - January 2015 August/September 2016

Phase 2 - Business 287 to 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive - Summer 2016 to Winter 2017

Phase 3 - 2 Lane bridge over Bus. 287 and Railroad - Early 2017 to Spring 2018

Design:

The design of the project will be completed in Four Major Tasks:

COMPLETED: Task 1 - Preliminary Design of Bailey Boswell Road from Bus. 287 to FM 156 and the 2-lane overpass

Task 2 - Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell from 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive to FM 156

Task 3 - Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell from Business 287 to 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive

Task 4 - Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell Overpass

Project Status Update - July 2016

Task 2 - Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell from 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive to FM 156: The design is complete and the project was bid and awarded to JLB Contracting Inc. The Construction Contract was awarded on September 23, 2014. Construction began in January 2015. All the construction for the project has been completed with the exception of sidewalks, irrigation, and barrier free ramps. A walk through is anticipated to occur by to September 1, 2016.



Task 3 - Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell from Business 287 to 500' West of Ash Meadow Drive:

The design for the project is complete and the project was bid on July 12, 2016. The contract for the project was awarded to JLB Contracting, LLC. It is anticipated the construction will begin in mid-September. Construction will begin on the eastern portions of the project where railroad permitting and TxDOT permitting are not needed, and the franchise utilities are clear of the construction.

The permitting process with BNSF Railway and UP Railroad is in process and anticipated to be complete by October 2016.

ESMT and Right-of-Way acquisition process is underway and anticipated to be complete by the end of the year. Franchise Utility Companies (gas, underground cable, overhead power, fiber optic) have relocated with the exception of AT&T and Oncor. Those relocations will be complete by the end of 2016. Construction will take 14-18 months.

Task 4 - Final Design and Construction Documents for Bailey Boswell Overpass:

The final design is underway. The permitting process with BNSF Railway and UP Railroad is underway. The bridge aesthetics options are being finalized to be presented to the City.
