BULKY BRUSH PICK-UP: Progressive Waste Solutions picks up bulky brush and tree limbs twice a year, on the second week of April and October. The next pick-up will begin the week of October 10, 2016. Brush must be out by the curb by 7 a.m. on Monday, October 10. It takes several days for the trucks to canvass the entire city. Brush and limbs bundled and not longer than four (4) feet in length or over 50 pounds will be picked up with regular garbage service.

The City of Saginaw and the Saginaw Police Department invite you to participate in the 32nd annual National Night Out (NNO) crime, drug, and violence prevention program sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch (NATW). The event will be held on the evening of Tuesday, October 4, 2016 and is expected to involve hundreds of Saginaw residents.

On October 4th, residents are encouraged to turn on their porch lights and gather with their neighbors to show unity against criminal activity. Registered communities may be visited by public service personnel such as those from Police, Fire, and other city officials. Without your help, NNO would not be possible. DOCUMENT/PAPER SHREDDING: Instant Shredding will be on site to dispose of your shredding.

FLAG RETIREMENT: American & Texas flag retirement by the Girl Scouts of America Troop 2702.

BULK WASTE ACCEPTED: Tree limbs, brush, furniture, tires, bulk household waste and appliances. Refrigerators, air conditioners or any appliance containing Freon must have proof of Freon removal attached to the appliance.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE ACCEPTED: Acids, aerosol cans, antifreeze, batteries (all kinds including car batteries), brake fluid, cooking oil, craft chemicals, degreasers, drain cleaner, fertilizer, fluorescent light bulbs, compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFL's), herbicides, household chemicals, motor oil, paints & stains, paint thinners, pest strips, pesticides, pharmaceuticals, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, oil filters, solvents, transmission fluid and varnish.

WHAT IS NOT ACCEPTED: Commercial or Industrial waste, ammunition, asbestos, building materials, butane cylinders, electronics, explosives, medical waste, PCB's, propane cylinders, radioactive material, smoke detectors and TV's.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPOSING OF WASTE:

- If a product is still usable; give it to someone instead of bringing it for disposal.
- Bring liquid paint sorted by type (i.e. latex, oil based and lead based).
- Keep chemicals in their original containers; place broken or leaking containers in a second container of like material (i.e. glass for corrosives, metal for flammables).
- If a container has no label and the contents are known, please place a label on the container clearly stating the contents.

RESIDENTS OF SAGINAW: Must provide a current residential water bill.
