


The current ASA and City of Saginaw Softball League Bylaws will govern play. Any additions and/or exceptions to the bylaws created specifically for the “Crazy Coed” league are as follows:

1. There will be only one umpire (home plate umpire) for each game. The umpire will be responsible for making all calls.
2. No Protests Allowed – The decision of the umpire is final.
3. Uniforms – All players on the team must have numbers on the back of the jersey. Like colored jerseys are not required.
4. The run rule and flip/flop rule will be in effect. In addition, each team may only score ten (10) runs per inning, with the only exception being the 7th inning of the game when you can score unlimited runs.
5. Teams must have a minimum of four (4) males and four (4) females present at game time to avoid forfeiting the game. Teams can play five (5) females and four (4) males or five (5) males and four (4) females to start the game with one out. **GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME!!!**
6. Teams may elect to use “Extra Players” (EP’s). If a team elects to use EP’s, they must finish the game with 12 players or an automatic out or outs will be charged to the position of the batting order for the player(s) who is unable to finish the game.
7. Batting Order – A batting order must be turned in to the scorekeeper prior to the start of the game. The batting order must be followed with no batter out of turn, and all batters batting before returning to the top of the batting order. Only ten (10) players (12 if EP’s are used) on the batting order turned in to the scorekeeper may bat. Substitutes must be reported to the umpire/scorekeeper. One courtesy runner may be used each inning by each team. Must be gender specific.
8. Roster – All team members **MUST** sign a team roster to be eligible to play, however, teams can have an unlimited amount of players on their roster. Players may only play on one team per league.
9. Each team must furnish a 12-inch, playable 52 COR. 300 compression softball for each game. All softballs must have the ASA or TAAF certification stamp. Softballs must be yellow optic. The Saginaw Recreation Center will have these balls available for sale for \$6.00 each.
10. If a male batter is walked, the next female batter has the option to walk only if there are two (2) outs.
11. All home runs over the fence will be an out.
