




Spay (Female)

(Ecollar included in price for male dogs.) *Spay terminates pregnancy

- * Age required for spay or neuter: 10 weeks-5 years. Weight required for appointment: 2-80lbs. TCAP does not perform surgery or dental cleanings on English Bulldogs.
- * All pets must have written proof of a current rabies vaccine or receive the vaccine at the time of surgery for \$5.
- * Drop-off is at 8am. Pick up is at 3pm.
- * Please do not feed dogs and cats after 10pm the night before surgery. Rabbits do not need to fast prior to surgery.
- * If dogs are actively in heat, they may be rescheduled for a later date, when they have finished their cycle.
- * If a pet's surgery is prolonged for any reason, a \$10.00 extended surgery fee will be assessed at the time of pick up. If this fee is assessed, it will be used in place of a crypt-orchid, in-heat or pregnancy fee.
