*In regards to the Quiet Zone at the east crossing on Bailey Boswell Road, this crossing was identified as a possible future quiet zone in the Quiet Zone Study completed in 2010. Making this railroad crossing a quiet zone was included in the Bailey Boswell Road Project and a "Notice of Intent" has been sent to the Federal Railroad Administration.*

Mr Mayor --

I have many safety issues with the upcoming Quiet Zone on Bailey Boswell.

From what I understand, a Notice of Intent is already in the works.

What I do not understand is the city of Saginaw's stance. Are you aware there are two main lines in this proposed Quiet Zone with a posted speed of 60mph?

A Quiet Zone was established at Denton Hwy @ Watauga Road. A few weeks later, a young boy was killed not far from the crossing.

A teacher in the EMS ISD alerted me that a student had been hit by a train at this new Quiet Zone that Saginaw has applied for.

A middle school and an elementary school buffer each side of this track.

These tracks were established decades before before any housing development.

Why is there only one quiet zone in Saginaw currently, but in an industrial area?

Train horns are a safety issue.

I ask you revoke the Notice of Intent. At least for a few years.

If you save the life of just one individual, it will be worth it.
