Over the past several months, the City of Saginaw has conducted a nationwide search for the next leader of the Saginaw Police Department. We invite you to be a part of this process by joining us on Saturday, June 16th from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at Saginaw High School for a public “Meet & Greet” with Finalists.

The Selection Process Overview

- ✓ Over 80 applications were received from 15 states.
- ✓ After a preliminary minimum qualification review, 27 applications were sent to an independent review panel organized by the North Central Texas Council of Governments Regional Police Academy.
- ✓ The review panel recommended 10 top candidates.
- ✓ These 10 candidates were asked to respond to a written exercise.
- ✓ Four (4) candidates from the top 10 will be interviewed in-person by a Selection Committee assembled by City Manager, Gabe Reaume.
- ✓ Finalists will participate in a public Meet & Greet on June 16th.

After the Meet & Greet, the City Manager will select the new Chief of Police.
