Academy Schedule

Academy classes will be held every Monday night from 6:30-9:00 pm with 2 additional (optional) Saturday sessions at the Saginaw Police Department. Classes include police administration, budgeting/personnel, criminal investigations, crime scene search, patrol, and police communications. Included is a trip to the gun range and other educative fieldtrips. Demonstrations will be provided throughout the academy from members of various specialized units such as traffic, SWAT, criminal investigations, police communications, and bicycle patrol.

How to Apply

Citizens interested in attending class must be at least 18 years of age, have a clear criminal history, and must work or live in the City of Saginaw. There is no cost for participation in this program, but you will graduate with a wealth of knowledge.
