SUBJECT: Action regarding Second Amendment/One Year Extension to Interlocal Agreement for Participation in City of Fort Worth's Household Hazardous Waste Program (October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016)

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

This item is for consideration of a one year extension of the existing Interlocal Agreement for Participation in the City of Fort Worth's Household Hazardous Waste Program. The extension is for the period of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016. The agreement allows residents to visit the collection center on Bridge Street or the mobile collection unit that will be in Saginaw later this year at no cost to the resident. The cost to the City will be \$47 per household per visit. This is the same fee as charged in the current agreement. (The first extension to the agreement was approved in July, 2014.)

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The financial impact will be \$47 per household per visit. A total of \$20,000 will be included in the 2015-2016 budget for this expense.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the second amendment/one year extension to the Interlocal Agreement for Participation in the City of Fort Worth's Household Hazardous Waste Program (October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016).

Attached is the contract amendment extending the annual contract with the City of Fort Worth for the disposal of household hazardous waste. There is no change in the contract and the cost will remain at \$47 per household per visit to the collection center or to the annual mobile collection event held at public works.

We have budgeted \$20,000 for next year which will allow 425 uses. I recommend approval of the contract amendment.

2. Anticipated Holiday Closures:

During the extended term of the agreement, the Environmental Collection Center (ECC) will be closed on the following holidays that are observed on days the ECC would otherwise be open to the public:

Thanksgiving holiday, Thursday and Friday, November 26-27, 2015
Christmas holiday, Friday, December 25, 2015
New Year's Day holiday, Friday, January 1, 2016

3. Miscellaneous:

All definitions, terms, conditions, and prices, as well as the rights and obligations of the parties as set forth in City Secretary Contract number 44805 shall remain unchanged except as expressly set forth herein.
